## **'Long Way' round the North Yorkshire Moors**

Yes it's a social event! Join Keith and Sarah as they make their way round the North Yorkshire Moors stopping for Fish and Chips at Whitby.

Departing from Squires Café at 9:30am (briefing at 9:20am) the route takes you along a number of well known biking roads which will not include motorways or dual carriageways. The day has been designed with rider comfort in mind so there will be a number of rider comfort and feeding stops:



TP (Cuppa Tea and a Pee) stop at Helmsley (20 Mins)

LTP (Lunch, Tea and a Pee) stop at Whitby (1 Hr)

TP (Cuppa Tea and a Pee) stop at Fridaythorpe (20 Mins)

We can't forget our bikes, so riders can feed their bikes at the planned fuel stop at Whitby. Those with gas guzzlers can also make use of the garage at Helmsley during the stop there.



We will use the drop-off system as described in the April edition of Tidings (page 25).

Don't worry too much as there will be a briefing at 9:20am before we set off and you will be given maps just in case.

In the event of adverse weather conditions, a decision will be made on the day whether to go ahead or change the route.
